Preregistration is required, payments made in advance, session run monthly. Minimum three children per school in order to provide transportation. Transportation is provided from school to Grant Park. Parents pick up at 6 p.m. Maximum 100 children. Schedule based on your school's calendar. No after school care when schools are not in session. No pick up on early dismissal day before noon. Any days where the students get out at noon or later VPD will provide transportation.

New Whittier and Riley After School Program

Veterans Park District is offering a New After School Program on site at Whittier and Riley schools beginning this Fall. After care staff will be on site providing homework help, snacks, various crafts and activities to Whittier and Riley students. District 87 is providing bus transportation from Riley School to Whittier School for the after school program.
